## About the Database

Access World News provided access to 4,454 national and international newspapers. Over the past 2.5 years, an average of 296 articles were downloaded per year. Our analysis indicated that the majority of content accessed was local Nebraska and South Dakota newspapers. The LLC has paper-copy subscriptions and/or microfilm copies of these newspapers—*Chadron Record*, *Lincoln Journal Star*, *Omaha World Herald*, and *Rapid City Journal*.

Content duplication, high per-use costs (\$16.73 per article download), and low utilization (approximately 95% of the database content was unused) contributed to our nonrenewal decision. Although most faculty, students, and staff will be unaffected, patrons should know that the majority of content provided by the database are freely available online with older content actively archived.
