Over 99 percent of content found within LexisNexis was not accessed since our subscription began in 2010. Of the remaining 1 percent of titles accessed, many were popular publications that are actively archived online, or are open access/defunct journals. Only 2 of these titles—*Financial Times* (UK) and *Sunday Times* (UK)—are subscription services.
