The LLC provides its patrons with more than 200,000 books and periodicals as well as 28 databases that make over 45,000 journals available for reading and research.

General Collection

A continuously revitalized collection of general studies and discipline-specific books is available on the LLC's upper level.

Fiction & Rotating Collections

The fiction collection is housed on the main level of the LLC. To keep holdings current, the LLC subscribes to two rotating collections, a general academic collection (main level) and a young adult collection (upper level).

Curriculum & Children's Library

The LLC provides an impressive array of books for teacher education and the Chadron community on the upper level.

Law Library

Housed on the upper level is the only print collection for legal studies in the three-county surrounding area.

Computers & Labs

The LLC is the largest computer lab on campus. It provides computers, tablets, and printers. Mediated classrooms, labs, and WiFi are also available.

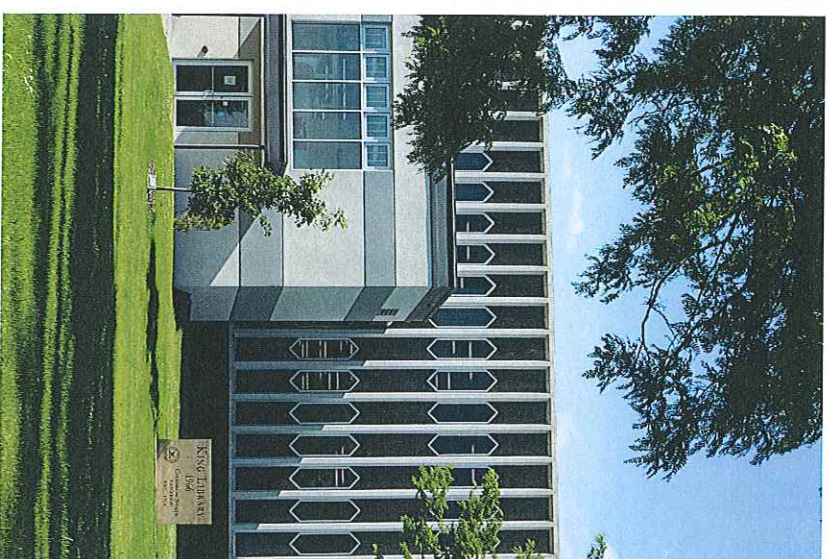

Introduction

The Chadron State College (CSC) Library was established in 1966; shortly after, the building was dedicated to Reta E. King, one of the Library's former directors.

In 2013, the traditional Library became the Library Learning Commons (LLC), a multiuse facility that, in addition to the library, includes the Learning Center, Transitional Studies, Career & Academic Planning Services, the IT Help Desk, Project Strive-TRIO, and Book Ends, a division of Dining Services that provides coffee, snacks, and light lunches.

Mission

The mission of the LLC is to serve as an educational, informational, and cultural resource center for CSC and the surrounding community, by providing knowledgeable staff and innovative services to support the effectiveness of learning.

Services

The LLC offers a broad array of services, which continue to evolve. These include:

Circulation & Reference

Librarians provide oversight for all lending (of books, equipment, and other media) in order to make borrowing easy and enjoyable. Librarians also staff the Reference Desk, providing support for research on campus and online.

Library Liaisons

Each academic department has a library liaison. Liaisons recommend book purchases to the departments and support them by customizing library tours, making classroom reservations, and providing research assistance.

Interlibrary Loan

The LLC shares a catalog with the two other Nebraska state colleges: Wayne State College and Peru State College. Books, journal articles, and other types of materials not owned by the LLC may be borrowed from these and other libraries. The LLC also maintains a reciprocal borrowing agreement with the Chadron Public Library.

Library Orientation

Librarians provide tours of the LLC, an overview library resources, and information about additional services. Tours are customized to meet faculty and student needs.

Room Reservations

The LLC makes a number of rooms and spaces available for faculty and staff to reserve. These rooms and spaces accommodate classes, web-conferencing, meetings, presentations, workshops, and trainings.

Open Education Resources

The LLC assists faculty interested in utilizing open education resources (OER) in their courses. Utilization of OER can reduce the costs of education and can provide students with greater access to timely information.

Graves Lecture Series

Each semester, the LLC hosts a series of scholarly presentations featuring distinguished speakers. The presentations are generally offered at 7:00 pm on Tuesday evenings every month. The Series is free and open to the public.

Turnitin Support

The LLC subscribes to Turnitin, a plagiarism-detection application and database. It also provides CSC faculty with Turnitin support and training.

Master Academic Plan Support

To assist with the Master Academic Plan (MAP), the LLC provides a site that articulates MAP priorities and sub-priorities and supports MAP-related project planning and development.
